

IMPORTANT SAFETY

PRECAUTIONS

When using your equipment, always follow basic safety precautions to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock and injury to persons, including the following:

- This equipment is NOT waterproof. DO NOT expose it to rain or moisture.

To avoid damage to your equipment, follow these simple precautions:


- Do not drop, puncture or disassemble any part of the equipment. There are no user-serviceable parts inside.



GETTING TO KNOW THE MOOV



SETTING UP YOUR MOOV POWER ON/OFF



CHARGE THE BATTERY


Charge the battery completely before using your moov.

1. Connect the AC adapter to the speaker USB port.

- 2. Plug the other end into a power supply (120V AC, (standard indoor).
- 3. The LED turns red and remains on while the battery is charging. It turns off when charging is complete.
- When the battery is low, the speaker beeps once every minute. When you hear the beeping, recharge the speaker.

PAIR MOOV WITH BLUETOOTH DEVICES

 Turn on your moov speaker. If this is the first time you have turned on the speaker, it will go into pairing mode automatically. (If this is not the first time, press MFB for 3 seconds until the LED blinks as blue.)



- 2. Set your mobile phone or Bluetooth device to discovery mode (Visibility on).
- Set your mobile phone or Bluetooth device to discover the moov, then locate the Bluetooth device list.
- 4. From the Bluetooth device list, select "moov."
- If you are prompted for a passkey, enter "0000" (four zeroes) and tap OK.
- 6. Your Bluetooth device indicates when pairing is complete.
- 7. The moov speaker announces "Connected" and the blue LED blinks 2 times every 5 seconds.

Auto Reconnect

Your moov speaker will try to reconnect to the last connected Bluetooth device when you turn on the speaker.

Simple Pairing

If your devices support Bluetooth v2.1 or higher, you don't need the passkey to pair them with the speaker.

Easy Pairing

Your moov speaker automatically goes into pairing mode the first time you use it.

ADDING ANOTHER SOURCE

Adding another audio device to the moov speaker requires using a 3.5mm stereo cable (included) with a 3.5mm plug on one end to connect with the AUX port on the moov.



OPERATING YOUR MOOV

PLAYING MUSIC

Press the MFB to play or pause music.

MAKING A CALL

To do this 	Try this
Redial last number	Press MFB twice.
Activate or deactivate voice dialing	 Press and hold MFB for 1 second. Make sure your phone supports the voice dial function. (Check your mobile phone instruction manual.)
Answer/hang up	Press MFB .
Decline an incoming call	Press and hold MFB for 1 second.
Transfer a call between the moov and your mobile phone	Press and hold MFB for 1 second.
Control the volume	Turn the volume control wheel. The speaker will beep when you have reached the minimum or maximum volume levels.
Mute/unmute the microphone	Hold the MFB for 3 seconds.

RESETTING THE SPEAKER

Press and hold the **MFB** button for 3 seconds while in pairing mode.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If	Try
The speaker will not turn on	Making sure it is charged or connected to a power outlet.
There is no audio from Bluetooth devices	 Turning up the volume on your Bluetooth devices. making sure the speaker is not muted. Making sure your Bluetooth devices are in range. Making sure your Bluetooth devices are connected to the speaker.
There is distortion	 Making sure moov is charged up. Making sure your speaker and Bluetooth devices are within range.
